

# Frequently Asked Questions

**What are program dates and times?** Program hours are Monday through Friday between 9:00am to 4:30pm. Students participate in school classes until 2:30pm with extra-curricular activities available between 2:30 and 4:30pm.

**How will I know if my application is approved?** Please give our office a call to confirm that your application has been received. You will be notified at that time if there are openings.

**Are computers provided for students?** Yes. All students will be provided access to a Chromebook while onsite at All THAT. This will hopefully prevent computers being lost, stolen or damaged with frequent transporting from home.

**Are meals provided for students?** Children's Hunger Alliance provides breakfast and lunch for students at our Learning Extension Center.

**Is transportation provided by All THAT?** Limited transportation to and from All THAT is provided via our 14 passenger mini buses if the student resides within our pick-up area. Our typical service area is between James Rd and Broad St, Hamilton Rd and Broad Street, Chatterton and Old Brice Rd and James and Winchester Pike. Bus routes/pick-up locations will be determined based on student enrollment.

There is also a bus stop located across the street from our site at 4117 E. Livingston Avenue.

**If my student is younger than 14 can they still participate in the All THAT program?** Only students 14 – 19 years old may participate in All THAT program opportunities.

**Orientation:** A parent or guardian and participating students **are encouraged** to attend an online ZOOM orientation or to take a tour of our program site prior to participating in All THAT activities. Please contact our office to obtain ZOOM links.

**Are students paid for participation in this program?** Students are provided a stipend based on active participation in the program.

**What safety precautions are being taken for students and staff?** All THAT routinely sanitizes our program space, encourages social distancing, provides masks and hand sanitizer and have installed acrylic shields in our classrooms.

- Students follow social distancing guidelines.
- Student and visitor temperatures are taken daily upon arrival.
- Single-use masks are provided.
